What are your tasks in the SIMPORT project (00:14 – 00:31 sec)?

We support all project partners with the implementation, especially with the learning app, and are mainly responsible for the dissemination, i.e. the transfer and publication of all project results in various ways.

How would you describe the project in one sentence (00:31 – 00:54 sec)?

In the SIMPORT project, frameworks are being developed to make apps that collect location data from users controllable and easier to understand, so that they know how, when and where data about their location is being recorded and they have control over it.
